

DETERMINING NJ EXPANDED INCOME ELIGIBILITY (NJEIE)

THE WORKING CLASS FAMILIES' ANTI-HUNGER ACT APPLIES TO PUBLIC AND CHARTER SCHOOLS AND PROVIDES AN ADDITIONAL STATE INCOME ELIGIBILITY LEVEL FOR FAMILIES WITH AN ANNUAL HOUSEHOLD INCOME BETWEEN 186 AND 199 PERCENT OF THE FEDERAL POVERTY LEVEL TO RECEIVE MEALS FREE OF COST.

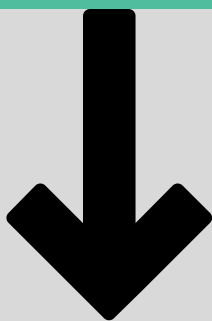
DETERMINE STUDENT ELIGIBILITY FOR FREE/REDUCED PRICE MEALS

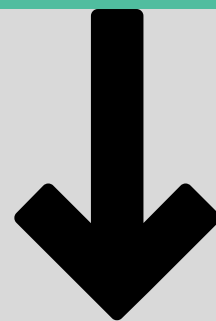
DETERMINE ELIGIBILITY FOR NJEIE

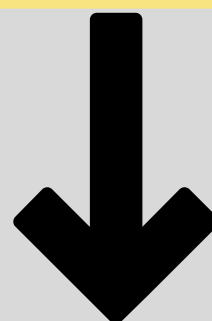


IF ELIGIBLE FOR NJEIE STATE SUPPLEMENT

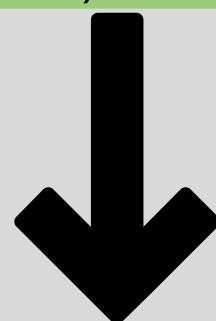
- Enter the student(s) in the Master Eligibility List (MEL) and Student Data System as Federal Paid (Denied) and New Jersey Expanded Eligible Free
