Dear Mr. Kimley and Mr. & Mrs. Coombs:

This letter is written to provide notice to you as parties involved in the referenced complaint that the Cumberland County Agriculture Development Board at its June 13th regular meeting performed its due diligence and determined that the property in question, known as Fairfield Township Block 52 Lot 52, does not meet the eligibility criteria for protection under the Right to Farm Act. Specifically, the property in question does not qualify as a commercial farm. In order to receive Right to Farm protection an operation larger than five acres must annually engage in agricultural or horticultural production worth at least \$2,500 and be eligible for differential property taxation under Farmland Assessment. The tax lot in question does not meet this eligibility requirement. Consequently, the Cumberland County Agriculture Development Board remands this matter back to the Cumberland County Department of Health for further action, which is hereby notified by copy of this letter.
