RIGHT TO APPEAL

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO APPEAL

- 1. Please be advised that pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 5:12-63(b), you have the right to appeal any final action or determination taken in your matter by the New Jersey Division of Gaming Enforcement (Division). You may be represented by an attorney, but you are not required to obtain an attorney.
- 2. The appeal process gives you the opportunity to be heard by the New Jersey Casino Control Commission (Commission) if you are unable to reach a settlement or are dissatisfied with the Division Director's final decision in your matter.
- 3. Please note: If you enter into a settlement with the Division, you will not be permitted to file an appeal in your matter.
- 4. You will have **20 days** from the date the Commission notifies you of your right to appeal and to complete and file an **Appeal Request Form** with the Commission.
- 5. If you wish to exercise your right to appeal you <u>must</u> do so in writing. Please complete and send an **Appeal Request Form** by mail, fax or email to the Commission's General Counsel's Unit. You may obtain a copy of the form on the Commission's website (www.nj.gov/casinos/services/forms) or one can be sent to you.
- 6. For more information concerning the appeal process or to request a form be sent to you, please contact the General Counsel's Office.
