# NEW JERSEY STATE PRISON THIRD AND FEDERAL STREETS <br> TRENTON, NEW JERSEY <br> 609-292-9700 

## FROM NORTH (ROUTE 1)

Follow Route 1 south (Note as you get into the Lawrenceville/Trenton area, be sure to stay on Route 1 - just below the Quakerbridge Mall Route 1 splits - STAY LEFT). Continue on Route 1 for about 2 miles - before the toll bridge to PA there are signs indicating Broad and Market Street exits - the next exit is Route 129 - take 129 exit. This exit can be easily missed; it is just immediately beyond the Market Street exit. It is best to stay in the right hand lane, as you approach Trenton to avoid missing the 129 exit. Stay on 129 (the prison should be visible on the right) to the Cass Street exit. Make a right onto Cass Street, the entrance to the Prison is on the right hand side, and the parking lot is to your left.

## FROM NORTH OR SOUTH ON THE NEW JERSEY TURNPIKE

## SOUTH

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to exit 7. Take Route 206 north to 195 West Exit (a right turn just before the White Horse Circle in Hamilton Township). Take 195 to Route 129 (Trenton). Follow Route 129 to the Cass Street exit. Make a left onto Cass Street. The entrance to the prison is on the right hand side, and the parking lot is to your left. NOTE: one can also go to Turnpike Exit 7A and follow directions below.

## NORTH

Take the New Jersey Turnpike to Exit 7A. Take 7A to 195 West. Following 195 to 129 (Trenton), continue on 129 to the Cass Street exit. Make a left onto Cass Street. The entrance to the prison is on the right hand side, and the parking lot is to your left.

## FROM SOUTH ON ROUTE 295

Take Rt. 295 North to Exit \#60 (Trenton \& Shore Points Exit). Bear left heading on Rt. 129 towards Trenton. Where Rt. 129 and Rt. 29 split, bear to the right and stay on Rt. 129 (you must bear right due to current construction in the area). Go to the second traffic light and turn left (Cass Street). The Prison will be on your right hand side and the parking lot on your left.
