### **VISITATION INFORMATION:**

To schedule a visit, call (973) 465-0068 Ext. 4402, Ext. 4403 or Ext. 4404, Monday to Friday from 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m. All visits must be scheduled seven (7) days in advance.

#### **General Population/Min Unit:**

Visitation will be offered on Saturday and Sunday with two (2) sessions 8:30 AM – 10:30 AM or 12:30 PM -2:30 PM {North & South compounds alternate session} Limit: (3) Adults, unlimited minors.

#### **Minimum Unit:**

Visitation will be offered Monday and Thursday 7:00 PM -8:00 PM. Limit: (3) Adults, unlimited minors.

#### **RHU:**

Visitation will be offered as a window visit (Non-Contact) Monday - Friday with two (2) session options: 5:00 PM – 6:00 PM or 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Limit (2) Adults, (2) Minors. (1 Visit every 30 days)

#### **Zero Tolerance:**

Visitation will be offered as a window visit (Non-Contact) Monday - Friday with two (2) session options: 5:00 PM -6:00 PM or 7:00 PM – 8:00 PM. Limit (2) Adults, (2) minors. (1 visit per week)

#### **Incarcerated Primary Caretaker Parents:**

Consistent with N.J.S.A. 30:1B-6.8, the visitation program for incarcerated primary caretaker parents will be offered Monday-Thursday 3:00 PM -6:00 PM and Saturday/Sunday 3:30 PM - 6:30 PM. Limit (3) Adults, unlimited minors.

Those approved for these visits must be properly demonstrate the incarcerated person has the role of primary caregiver to their child/children under the age of 18 via the Primary Caretaker Intake Form and Application (available in the law library, at orientation and on the housing units.) NOTE: Applications are currently being accepted.

**(CONTINUED)**

Those incarcerated parents whose access to the child/children has been terminated by court order or other circumstance are not eligible.

Social Services may assist in the completion of the application as well in obtaining documentation maintained by NJDOC. It is the responsibility of the incarcerated person to obtain any documentation not maintained by the NJDOC.

A determination of eligibility and approval will be made via a classification committee review.
