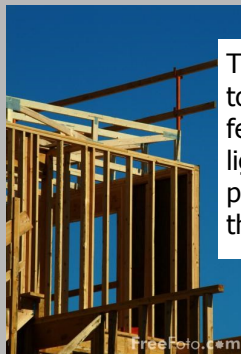

The CDC and the US Fire Administration have created a comprehensive plan for career and volunteer fire departments to create and maintain an active community risk reduction campaign. Traditionally fire safety education at the department level has suffered both from a lack of real support and the lack of a real plan.

The greatest ally a firefighter can ask for is a community that is aware of the risk fire presents to them and is armed with the knowledge of what they can do as individuals to prevent it. There is no more credible speaker in the world than a firefighter on the subject of fire and sadly not enough of them speak. Think of it as perhaps giving the folks you risk your life for a chance to save yours.
