Towerview History

The home of Samuel Leeds Allen III and Senator Diane Allen started out as a small simple farm house on land owned by Elias Boudinot, member of the Continental Congress. The house was enlarged in the Italian villa style in 1855, and later remodeled as a grand Colonial Revival house. A succession of owners made this a summer residence, then a year-round home. The Allens continue to be conscientious stewards of

their historic riverbank mansion.
