
Exits to Reunification

In 2012, New Jersey 63.7% of the children exiting placement were being reunified. This puts New Jersey on the high end of the range for the percentage of children reunified, and ranks us #19 among the 50 states, District of Columbia and Puerto Rico.



Note: This map is for 2012, and the darker color indicates a higher percentage of exits to reunification

New Jersey has shown continued improvement in the percentage of children leaving foster care for reunification resulting as indicated in the table below:
