

County Inter-Agency Coordination Councils' (CIACC) Educational Partnerships

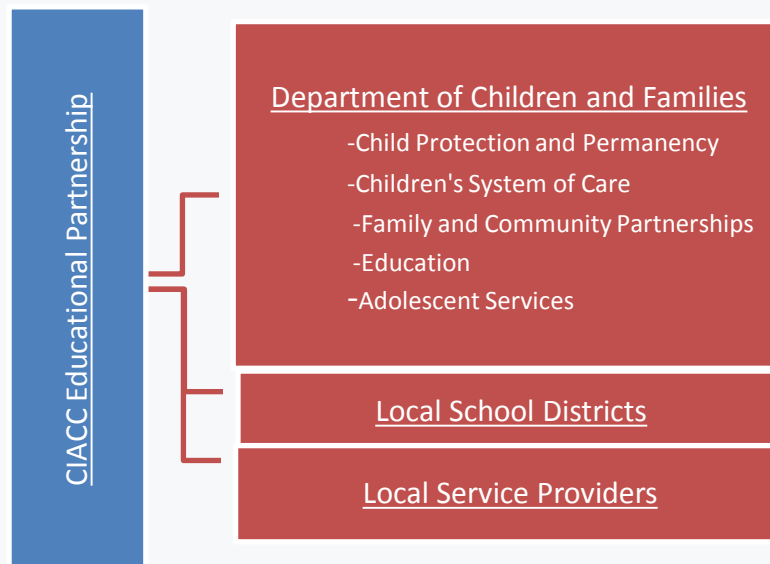
Structure

County Inter-Agency Coordinating Councils' (CIACC) Educational Partnerships are alliances between local school districts and local agencies that serve children and families. These partnerships provide cross-systems training and help direct resources and services from the New Jersey Department of Children and Families (DCF) and other sources to families in need.

Services

CIACC's Educational Partnerships train local school personnel, DCF staff, and local service providers throughout the school year. Training programs teach participants about services and resources available from DCF, local schools, and other agencies. Each partnership is supported by a locally maintained web portal that contains archived training materials, up-to-date resource links, and contact information.
