She reported that she and the children had laid down for a nap; however, they woke up, managed to unlock the door, and leave the apartment without her knowledge. Description of Incident: On 1/9/16, F.R. was found unresponsive and 911 was called. He was transported to the hospital and pronounced at 8:51 a.m. Law enforcement reported that they found a bottle of rubbing alcohol wedged between his bed and the wall. When questionned, F.R.'s father, P.M., admitted that he had left it on top of the dresser the previous night. An autopsy report was completed which identified the cause of death as "ethanol poisoning." These findings were reviewed by personnel from the Jersey Shore Medical Center. Because there was "no acetone" found in F.R.'s sytem, it was concluded that his death was likely caused by some of the items, (e.g., beer, wine, or whiskey" found in the home. These items were observed and determined to be easily accessible to the children. In addition, it was learned that during the time that F.R.'s mother, J.R. was supervising him, (i.e., 1/8/16), he was screaming and vomiting. However, neither medical advice nor treatment was obtained. CP&P completed a Child Protection Service (CPS) investigation and substantiated J.R. for neglect/child death.

A CPS investigation was completed and the finding was unfounded. This case was closed on 4/14/11. Ocean South LO.

On 4/29/11, it was alleged that F.R.'s parents were abusing illegal substances and/or prescription drugs. A CPS investigation was completed and the finding was unfounded. Ocean South LO.

On 10/7/11, a report was made to the NJ Abuse hotline noting domestic violence between F.R.'s parents. It was alleged that P.M. physically assaulted J.R. in the presence of their child. A CPS investigation was completed and the finding was unfounded. Ocean South LO.

was abusing marijuana. A CPS investigation was completed and the finding was unfounded. Newark Center City LO. This case was closed on 12/12/12.

On 12/18/12, staff from M.M.'s school reported that he had a bruise on the side of his face. They stated that it appeared as if his skin had been removed. M.M. told school staff that his mother beat him with a belt. The Newark Center City LO completed a CPS investigation and the finding was unfounded. This case was closed on 3/5/13.

On 1/24/14, it was alleged that M.M.'s sibling had bruises and marks on his body from being hit with a belt by his mother. The referent also stated that his mother had not followed up with some necessary medical services. The Newark Center City LO completed a CPS investigation and the finding was not established. This case was closed on 2/27/14.

On 3/7/14, the State Central Registry (SCR) was contacted regarding K.R. The reporter claimed that K.R. hit her children, drank excessively, and smoked marijuana. In addition, it was noted that she had drug dealers and gang members residing in her home. The Newark Center City LO completed a CPS investigation and the finding was not established. This case was opened for services.

On 5/8/14, staff from M.M.'s school reported that they had attempted to speak to K.R. regarding a school matter, but she was not home. Her live-in boyfriend came outside and appeared to be under the influence of drugs. The Newark Center City LO completed a CPS investigation and the finding was not established.

On 7/7/14, during a visit, M.M.'s father alleged that he observed welt marks on his son's arms. Reportedly, M.M. disclosed that his mother beat him with an extension cord. The Newark Center City LO 's CPS investigation yielded a finding of not established. This case was closed on 9/9/14.

On 10/16/14, the vice principal of his M.M.'s school contacted SCR. He shared that M.M. had been suspended and failed to return on the designated date. A Child Welfare Service (CWS) Assessment was completed and the case was opened for services.

On 1/14/15, due to concerns regarding M.M.'s sibling (4 months) with respect to failure to thrive issues, SCR was contacted by University Hospital personnel. It was reported that K.R. had not been cooperative and was not forthcoming about the child's diet. The Newark Center City LO substantiated K.R. for neglect.

On 7/14/16, it was reported that M.M. had a circular mark on his face that appeared to be a "cigarette burn." The Newark Center City LO completed a CPS investigation and the finding was not established. This case remains open.
