Dear Mr. Lefke:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Atlantic County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 22, 2021. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion to rectify certain inconsistencies between the Atlantic County Utilities Authority (ACUA) Multi-Class B/C Recycling Center General Approval and the County Plan. ACUA is located at 6700 Delilah Road, Block 703, Lots 5, 6, & 7 in Egg Harbor Township.

Specifically, ACUA is requesting the following modifications to the County Plan to make the County Plan consistent with their Class B/C Recycling General Approval:

- The company name is Atlantic County Vegetative Waste Recycling Center.
- There is no Class C throughput capacity in tons per day as there is for Class B operations. The current Class C throughput capacity is 14,147,690 cubic yards per year. The volume is calculated as 322 tons per day based on peak season figures.
- The hours of operation for the Class B/C facility are as follows: (winter hours) 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. (noon) on Saturday, and (summer hours) 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. on Saturday. The ACUA reserves the right to modify the schedule on holidays if the facility is in operation.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion to rectify certain inconsistencies between the ACUA General Approval and the County Plan can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion to update the facility name, Class B/C status, Class C throughput capacity, and hours of operation, is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
