Dear Mr. Lefke:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Atlantic County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated June 25, 2021. The subject request proposes County Plan inclusion to rectify certain inconsistencies between the Old Cape, Inc. (Old Cape), Class B Recycling General Approval (GA) and the County Plan. Old Cape is located at 3025 Ocean Heights Avenue, Block 6715, Lots 2 and 7 in Egg Harbor Township.

Specifically, Old Cape is requesting the following modifications to the County Plan to make the County Plan consistent with their GA:

- The facility name is Old Cape, Inc.
- The facility is located at Block 6715 and Lots 2 and 7.
- The throughput capacity and accepted materials is for concrete, asphalt, brick, concrete block, cinder block, brush, tree parts, tree stumps and wood (non-chemically treated and unpainted) with a capacity of 258 tons per day (tpd), (170 tpd of concrete, asphalt, concrete, brick, concrete block, and cinder block and 88 tpd of brush, tree parts, tree stumps, and wood).
- The hours of operation for Old Cape are as follows: 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday and 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. on Saturday.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion to rectify certain inconsistencies between the Old Cape GA and the County Plan can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion to update the facility name, lot and block, throughput capacity, accepted materials, and hours of operation, is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
