The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated July 5, 2018. This amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of a name change of the Miele Sanitation Company, Inc. Transfer Station/Materials Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) and Class A & B Recycling Center located on Block 1205, Lots 3.01, 10 & 11 at 60 Railroad Avenue in the Borough of Closter to I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. – Closter. The above noted change in name will not result in any operational changes.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)14, the inclusion of a change in name of an existing solid waste facility and/or recycling center can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of a change in name of the Miele Sanitation Company, Inc. TS/MRF and Class A & B Recycling Center to I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. – Closter is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
