Dear Mr. Wierer:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a request for an administrative action to the Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated August 24, 2015. The August 24, 2015 request proposes County Plan inclusion of the acceptance and processing of a maximum of 100 tons per day (tpd) of Class A recyclable material at the I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF) located on Block 34.02, Lot 41; Block 48.02, Lot 16.01; Block 52, Lot 46 and Block 220, part of Lot 7, 19-35 Atlantic Street, in the City of Garfield, New Jersey. The total capacity of the I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. TS/MRF shall remain at 750 tpd (up to a maximum of 3,520 tons per week) inclusive of the Class A recyclable material.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, County Plan inclusion of the modification of an existing facility, including the acceptance of additional waste types, constitutes an approvable administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of the acceptance and processing of Class A recyclable materials at I.W.S. Transfer Systems of NJ, Inc. TS/MRF is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).

Please be advised that this administrative action approval shall not be construed as an expression of the Department's intent to issue a permit modification to the subject facility for the above noted operational changes.
