
The Department of Environmental Protection's (Department) Solid and Hazardous Waste Management Program is in receipt of a request for administrative action to the Bergen County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated November 9, 2012. The subject request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes to amend the operating schedule of the Waste Management of New Jersey, Inc. (WMNJI) Transfer Station/Material Recovery Facility (TS/MRF), located on Block 501, Lots 7 and 8 at 61 Broad Street in the Borough of Fairview. Specifically, the November 9, 2012 request for administrative action to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of the subject facility to accept and process certain solid wastes and recyclables 24 hours per day, Monday through Saturday.

The County Plan inclusion of the above noted change in operating schedule will not result in any other operational changes at this WMNJI TS/MRF, which is included in the County Plan with a capacity of 950 tons per day (4,800 tons per week) of solid waste types 10, 13, 13C, 23, and 27 and Class A and Class B recyclable material.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)5, a change in the operating hours of an existing solid waste facility can be accomplished through an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of a change in the operating schedule of the WMNJI TS/MRF in the Borough of Fairview is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
