The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Sustainable Waste Management is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the NJSEA District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) received by the department on January 8, 2024. This request for Plan Inclusion for the following actions: update the legal name of a facility from North Bergen Recycling to Tilcon New York Inc. (North Bergen); incorporate the address of the facility as 9505 Fairview Avenue and 95<sup>th</sup> Street, North Bergen, Hudson County; updated the Block and Lot from Block 465, Lots 33-39 to Block 463, Lots 3 & 5, Block 464, Lots 1.01, 12, 14 & 35, Block 465, Lots 32 & 33 and Block 480, Lot 4; updated the approved materials for the facility to include brick and block in addition to asphalt and concrete; maintain the total capacity for the facility at 500 tons per day of recyclable materials; and update the hours of operation from 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 am to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Saturday.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b), the application to amend the NJSEA District Solid Waste Management Plan can be accomplished via administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of Tilcon New York Inc. (North Bergen) facility is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11.
