The Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Solid and Hazardous Waste is in receipt of a proposed amendment to the Union County District Solid Waste Management Plan (County Plan) dated March 26, 2020. The amendment to the County Plan proposes County Plan inclusion of Wakefern Food Corporation Class A Recycling Center, to be located at 704-742 York Street (Block 8, Lot 1870) in the City of Elizabeth. The facility proposes to accept, process, and transfer up to 570 tons per day of source-separated corrugated cardboard, plastic, paper, and metal from supermarkets operating as part of the Wakefern cooperative only.

Pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(b)3, the inclusion of a new recycling facility for the acceptance of Class A recyclables can be accomplished via an administrative action. Therefore, the County Plan inclusion of Wakefern Food Corporation Class A Recycling Center located in the City of Elizabeth is hereby approved as an administrative action pursuant to N.J.A.C. 7:26-6.11(f).
