

BLUEBACK HERRING

Alosa aestivalis

Description:

- ♦ back bluish gray to dark blue with silver sides
- ***** usually dark spot on shoulder
- black peritoneum (lining of the abdominal cavity)
- lower jaw equal to snout or just beyond
- upper jaw extends back to beginning of eye

Size:


♦ up to 15 inches; average 11-12 inches

Range:

♦ Cape Breton, Nova Scotia to St. John's River, Florida

Fact:

- spawn in coastal rivers during the spring
- ♦ young move out towards ocean waters at about 1 month of age
- lifespan about 8 years
