APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR FILLET PERMIT APPLICATION FOR PARTY BOATS

- 1. Fully complete application with information requested:
- 2. Provide number of passengers your vessel is licensed to carry as indicated on the United States Coast Guard Certificate of Inspection. A minimum of 15 passengers, not including crew members, are required to be eligible for the Fillet Permit. YOU MUST SUBMIT A COPY OF THE CERTIFICATE OF INSPECTION WITH YOUR APPLICATION.
- 3. Sign and date the application. Enclose check or money order in the amount of \$2.00 to cover application fee. (Make check payable to <u>STATE OF NEW JERSEY</u>).

- 5. Retain copies of everything you submit for your records.

NOTE: The permit, once issued, will be valid in subsequent calendar years unless suspended or revoked as part of a penalty action or the owner is notified of a regulatory modification.
