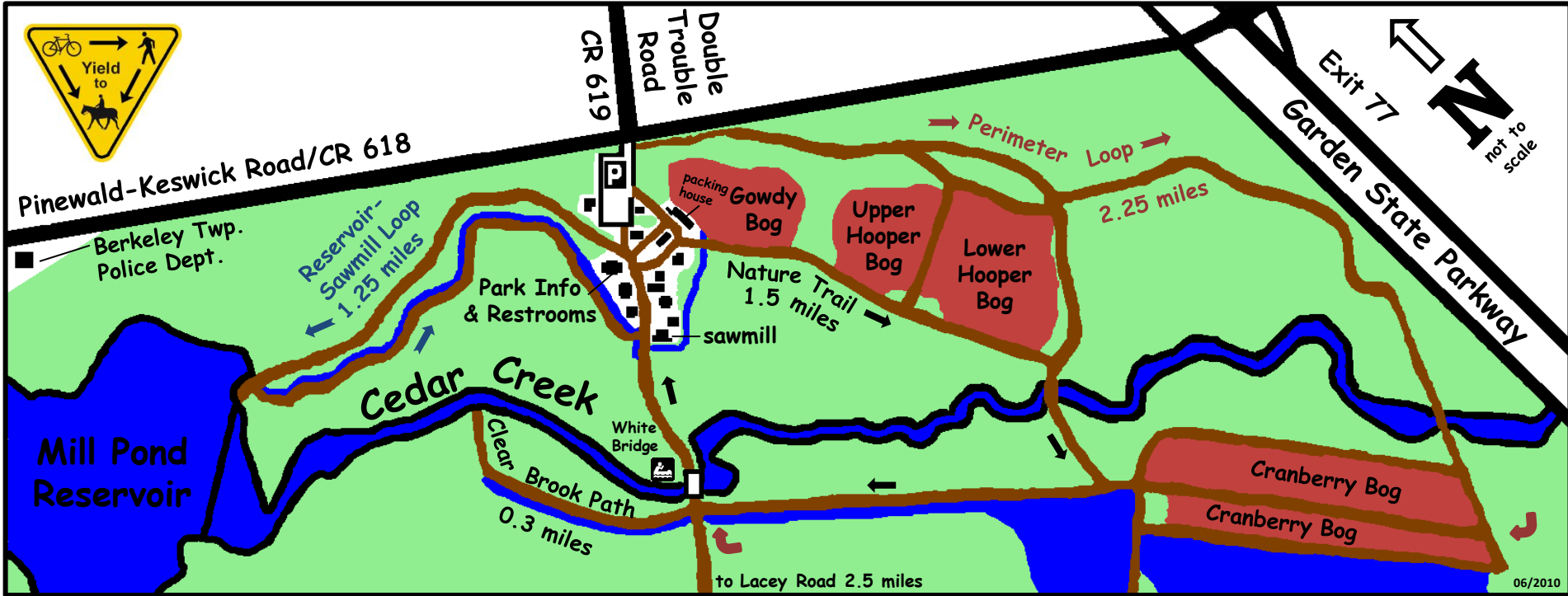




# Double Trouble State Park

## Historic District Trails and Cranberry Bogs

The Double Trouble Historic District has a marked nature trail and several miles of unmarked paths along sand service roads. Nature trail guides are available at the trailhead next to the cranberry packing house, at the park information building, and as a download from the Double Trouble section on the New Jersey State Parks and Forests website, [www.njparksandforests.org](http://www.njparksandforests.org).

Double Trouble Village is an active cranberry farm. Visitors are asked to use caution around the bogs and reservoirs. Vehicles are not permitted beyond the parking area except for canoe access at the White Bridge. Horseback riding & mountain biking are permitted on existing sand roads only. No ATVs or motorized vehicles. Pets must be on a leash at all times and owners must clean up after their pets.
