Petitioner: Amy Black

Take notice that on April 5, 2017, the Department of Environmental Protection

(Department) received a petition for rulemaking from Amy Black (petitioner). The petitioner

requests that the Department amend the Noise Control rules, N.J.A.C. 7:29, in particular N.J.A.C.

7:29-1.2, Industrial, commercial, or community service facilities, to apply the sound level limits

to noise from residential properties. Petitioner further asks that the Department amend the rules

to allow the sound level limits from industrial, commercial, and community service facilities, and

residential properties to be based on measurements at the property line to protect people in the

public right of way. Petitioner states that measuring the decibel level from the facility's or

residence's property line, rather than from another property, would better protect the public.

Petitioner is primarily concerned with noise from commercial yard equipment and leaf blowers.
