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BDA Summary

Applicant: The Salem Industrial District Brownfield Development Area (Salem BDA) Steering Committee consists of the City of Salem, Salem County, Stand Up for Salem volunteer committee members, Anchor Glass, Wire Pro, Inc., National Docks, LLC, Bermuda International Terminals, St. John's Pentecostal Outreach Church, and Broadway United Methodist Church. The New Jersey DEP Office of Brownfield Reuse provides the Salem BDA Steering Committee with guidance concerning technical, financial, and redevelopment issues.

Location: The physical boundaries of the Salem BDA include the Salem River Cut-Off, Salem River, and Fenwick Creek to the North, the Salem Sanitary Landfill to the west, South Front Street, West Broadway Street, and Fifth Street to the South, and Market Street to the East. Two non-contiguous redevelopment areas in the vicinity of Hubbell Avenue and Keasbey Street are also included within the boundaries of the Salem BDA.

Size: 229.89 Acres

Description: The Salem BDA consists of various industrial properties, former gasoline service stations, a heating oil storage facility, and the Salem Sanitary Landfill.

Potential Contaminants: Petroleum Hydrocarbons, Polynuclear Aromatic Hydrocarbons, Metals, and Historic Pesticides.

Proposed Reuse: Highly visible, dilapidated properties are located on either side of the Route 49 Gateway into Salem City. These properties significantly detract from the aesthetics of the waterfront area and potentially pose an environmental threat. The City of Salem anticipates preparing a Smart Growth Plan for the Waterfront Industrial area that will provide a detailed market study, land use plan, and conceptual site plan once the environmental assessment of the Brownfield properties and vision planning are completed.

Benefits of the Salem BDA: A mix of commercial, modern light industrial, and maritime port uses for the redevelopment will provide economic revitalization to the area. A wetlands interpretive center is also planned for a portion of the expansive waterfront tract where wetlands education and the study of the restoration of an original tidal flow tributary can be conducted.

Additional benefits of the Salem BDA are the expanded availability of funding assistance through grants awarded from the Hazardous Discharge Site Remediation Fund and a consolidated assignment of all sites in the Salem BDA boundaries to one NJDEP Case Manager. The coordination of the redevelopment aspects and remediation activities for these sites will provide an efficient and effective approach to facilitating the restoration and environmental cleanup of the properties located in the Salem BDA.
