



An Automated E-mail Flood Warning System



The program retrieves AHPS data from the internet and compares forecasted stages to station specific Flood Action Levels. If the forecasted stages exceed the station specific Flood Action Level, the program generates and sends an e-mail warning to a List Server. By subscribing to the List Server, individuals can get e-mail warnings about forecasted flood events on the main stem Delaware River, the Lehigh River, and the Schuylkill River.
