## Tuscarora Inn Rules and Regulations for overnight guests and field trip participants

Parent/guardian and students are required to read the following code of behavior and rules of conduct and to sign this form indicating their understanding of its importance.

1. Students may drive to the conference if parents permit; however, ignition keys must be left with conference registrar for the duration of the conference.
2. Students are NOT permitted to leave the facility grounds unless prior authorization is provided.
3. Radios, tape/cd players, pagers, and cellular phones are NOT permitted. Walkmans with headphones must be kept in rooms.
4. Alcoholic beverages, use of tobacco products, and illegal substances are NOT permitted.
5. Persons of the opposite sex are NOT permitted in each other's rooms.
6. Knives, firearms, or other implements are NOT permitted.
7. Students are to participate in all organized functions in a timely manner.
8. Life jackets MUST be worn at all times when on the water and all proper safety procedures must be followed at all times.
9. Students are responsible for their own personal belongings. Please do not bring valuables. A small amount of cash may be used at the soda machines located on the conference site.
10. Students are expected to keep their rooms clean and maintain a respect for others and the facility at all times.
