

350' of Public Access on the West Branch in Deposit








Ramping all releases

New release protocols need to include a provision to cushion the impact of sudden reduced releases. All releases including "directed releases" should be ramped both up and down gradually, at rates determined by state fishery experts.







Thermal Refuge Areas

- Found at tributary mouths delivering cold water, bottom of deep pools, groundwater seep areas, and in cooler tributaries.
- Can cause significant stress to fish when used.
- <u>Crowding in thermal refuge areas</u> leads to increased predation, disease transmission, weight loss and decreased reproductive success.

Drivers of the Aquatic Environment

Water Temperature

- Determines metabolism: trout lose weight and fitness when water temperatures > 68°F.
- Coldwater fish (Trout) must migrate to find cooler water when water temperatures > 72°F or they will die.
