

A RESOLUTION further extending the experimental modification of release schedules from Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink reservoirs.

BE IT RESOLVED By The Delaware River Basin Commission:

1. Subject to the provisions of paragraph two of this resolution, the experimental modification of the release schedules of Cannonsville, Pepacton and Neversink reservoirs, pursuant to Docket No. D-77-20 and Resolution No. 81-25 is extended from May 31, 1982 to May 31, 1983.

2. The releases provided for in paragraph one hereof shall be subject to the limits based on storage levels for drought warning and drought periods as provided in the Rules and Regulations of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Part 671, and the Stipulation of Discontinuance in The City of New York vs. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Index No. 5840-80.

3. This resolution is contingent upon the continuing unanimous consent of the parties to the U. S. Supreme Court Decree entered in New Jersey vs. New York, 347 U. S. 995 (1954), which is set forth in the attached Consent to Action.






