## Driving Directions to the Giving Pond Recreation Area, Upper Black Eddy, Pa.

The Giving Pond Recreation Area is on River Rd. (PA Rte. 32) between the Frenchtown, NJ/Uhlerstown, PA and the Milford, NJ/Upper Black Eddy, PA river bridges.

Most online map programs will find the Giving Pond at 1136 River Rd., Upper Black Eddy, Pa.

There is construction on River Rd./Rte. 32 both north and south of the Giving Pond, so traveling through New Jersey to reach it is advisable.

If you cross the Frenchtown Bridge, turn right on River Rd/Rte. 32 and go 0.9 mi., the Giving Pond parking lot will be on your left.

From the Milford Bridge, turn left on River Rd/Rte. 32 and go 2.4 mi. The Giving Pond parking lot will be on your right.

## Directions from Giving Pond Recreation Area to Amico Island Park, Riverside, N.J.

Amico Island is where the Rancocas Creek meets the Delaware River in Delran Township, Burlington County, N.J.

Estimated Driving Time: 1 hour 30 minutes; about 51 miles

	Start - Make Right onto PA 32 South	0.9 mi
	Turn Left onto Bridge Street, crossing into New Jersey	0.3 mi
	Turn Right onto NJ 29 South, towards Lambertville and Trenton	11.7 mi
 	Turn Slight Right onto NJ 29/CR 519/Daniel Bray Highway/Kingwood-Stockton Rd. Continue to follow NJ 29/Daniel Bray Highway	0.6 mi
 	Turn Slight Right onto North Main Street/NJ 29/Daniel Bray Highway. Continue to follow NJ 29 South.	13.1 mi
	Merge onto I95 S via ramp on the Left, crossing into Pennsylvania.	11.7 mi
	Take the PA 413 S/Exit 40, toward I276/Burlington Bristol Bridge/Bristol	1.5 mi
 	Turn Slight Right onto New Rodgers Rd./PA 413. Continue to follow PA 413.	1.1 mi
 	Turn Slight Right onto New Rodgers Rd./PA 413 S, crossing into New Jersey	1.9 mi
 	Enter next roundabout and take first exit onto Keim Blvd./NJ 413S	0.1 mi
 	Turn Slight Right onto Camden Ave./US 130 South; continue to follow US 130S	6.1 mi
	Turn Right onto South Chester Ave.	1.5 mi
	Turn Left onto St. Mihiel Drive/NJ 543/River Road	0.2 mi
	Turn Right onto Norman Ave. - it will be your third right	0.3 mi
	End at Amico Island Park, Riverside, N.J. Entrance is at the end of the road, past the large marina on the left.
