COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION DECISION

The record of this matter – wherein respondent was charged with excessive absenteeism, insubordination and unbecoming conduct – and the advisement of his failure to appear at hearing, transmitted by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 1:1-14.4, have been reviewed. On February 22, 2007, a notice providing respondent with an opportunity to submit an explanation of his nonappearance was sent to counsel by the OAL; on February 27, 2007, upon receipt of the record, the Department sent a second notice directly to respondent because his designated counsel – to whom the OAL notice was addressed – had been relieved of his obligation to provide representation by a February 16, 2007 Order of the Administrative Law Judge. Notwithstanding such notice, no explanation was filed by respondent.

In light of respondent's failure to appear at hearing, the charges against him – previously found sufficient, if true, to warrant dismissal or reduction in salary – are deemed admitted, and respondent is accordingly dismissed from his employment as a tenured custodian with the Trenton Board of Education as of the date of this decision.^{*}
