The Commissioner has reviewed the record of this matter and the decision of the School

Ethics Commission (SEC) – finding that respondent violated N.J.S.A. 18A:12-24(b) of the School Ethics

Act (SEA) when he "engaged in a brief conversation with a candidate for the position of interim

superintendent, and also discussed with [the candidate] the general nature of the community and school

system." SEC Decision at 5 (internal quotation marks omitted). The SEC's decision was forwarded -

pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:12-29 – for the Commissioner's final determination on the recommended penalty

of reprimand. Respondent has neither filed exceptions to the recommended penalty, nor has he instituted

an appeal of the SEC's underlying finding of violation pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:4 et seq.

Upon review, the Commissioner concurs with the penalty recommended by the SEC in

consequence of respondent's conduct. Accordingly, respondent is hereby reprimanded as a school official

found to have violated N.J.S.A. 18A:12-24(b).
