ROBERT M. EGLES : ORDER OF REVOCATION

At its meeting of April 4, 2014, the New Jersey State Board of Examiners (Board) reviewed an affidavit that Robert M. Egles had submitted pursuant to an Order to Show Cause that had been issued to him. In September 2013, Egles was convicted of Lewdness and was disqualified from public school employment pursuant to *N.J.S.A.* 18A:6-7.1 *et seq.* Egles currently holds a Substitute Credential, which expires in July 2015.

Egles agreed to relinquish his credential with the force and effect of a revocation and all attendant consequences in his affidavit to that effect to the Board. At its meeting of April 4, 2014, the Board voted to accept Egles' relinquishment with the force and effect of a revocation pursuant to *N.J.A.C.* 6A:9-17.8.

Accordingly, on this 4th day of April 2014 it is therefore ORDERED that Robert M. Egles' Substitute Credential be revoked effective immediately.
