INTRODUCTION

This directory lists New Jersey private schools approved to provide special education programs to public school students in accordance with New Jersey Administrative Code 6A:14 Subchapter 7. The Individualized Education Program (IEP) team for a student with educational disability can consider placement in special classes, separate schooling or other removal from the student's regular class only when the nature or severity of the educational disability is such that education in the student's regular class with the use of appropriate supplementary aids and services cannot be achieved satisfactorily.

The directory also identifies schools that are licensed by the Department of Human Services (DHS) to provide residential programs. DHS is responsible for licensing and monitoring of all residential child care facilities in New Jersey.
