The US is in a Climate Change Emergency and New Jersey should be one of the states addressing our climate emergency. I am alarmed by the findings presented in the Integrated Energy Plan. It is CRITICAL that you take all steps to address these critical structural deficiencies before finalizing the IEP and EMP.

Improvements to the Integrated Energy Plan that need to be made:
