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# New Jersey State Health Assessment Data: NJ's Public Health Data Resource



The New Jersey Center for Health Statistics' State Health Assessment Data (NJSHAD) System provides access to public health datasets and information on the health status of New Jerseyans.

The system has three main sections:

- Links to NJDHSS Publications
- Public Health Indicator Profiles
- Customizable Public Health Data Query System



## Indicator Profiles

An indicator profile is a brief online report that contains data, graphs, and easy-to-understand explanations for a specific public health issue. This includes its public health context, what the current status is, and what is being done to improve it. Graphs provide a visual representation of the data and

descriptive summaries provide answers to the most commonly asked questions about the public health topic being addressed.

## Custom Data Queries

A custom query is an interface (set of web pages) where the user can select a dataset (e.g., births) and a measure (e.g., count) and then limit the results by year, age

group, county, etc. to obtain specific data. Measures include rates, survey topics, medians, and averages. The options available for limiting are dataset-dependent. For example, mortality data may be limited by year, cause of death, age, gender, race/ethnicity, and geography (county, municipality).



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
