## EMT TRAINING FUND COURSE REIMBURSEMENT - Effective January 1, 2002

- 1. The rate of reimbursement for EMT-Basic course candidates, who successfully complete the 120-hour training program, will be increased to \$550 per student. This new rate reflects the intent of the law and of the needs of sponsoring agencies.
- There will be a new fee schedule. This new fee schedule will more accurately reflect the costs associated with conducting an EMT-Basic training program, and will allow for a more equitable payment distribution. Training programs must continue to maintain accurate records for audit purposes.
- 3. There will be only one course payment, which will be made at the conclusion of the course, after all paperwork has been submitted and is accurate in all areas. Program sponsors and course coordinators need to review and evaluate their financial situation to ensure that adequate funding is available to conduct their next program.
