The Red Book – Local Health Department Emergency Contact Directory (Red Book) is a directory of local health department personnel, which provides a mechanism that allows for emergency communication 24 hours per day, seven days per week, including weekends and holidays, in accordance with Public Health Practice Standards of Performance for Local Boards of Health in New Jersey (N.J.A.C. 8:52-12.2(a)1).

Local health officers, or their designated personnel, are responsible for verifying and updating listings for their health department, in the Red Book. Listings include each local health department’s demographics, after-hours contact information for the health department’s licensed health officer, alternate emergency after-hours contacts, and health officer relief coverage contact information.
