

## **Major Industry Sectors Where Silicosis Cases Were Exposed**

Nearly all of the cases for which industry was known were exposed while employed in five major industry sectors: Manufacturing (n=386, 69%), Mining (n=85, 15%), Construction (n=72, 12%), Services (n=12, 2%) and Transportation (n=8, 1%) (Figure 1). Three sectors, namely, Agriculture, Retail Trade and the Military had two or fewer cases each. Over the past three decades, the number of cases identified in Manufacturing, Mining and Transportation declined, while those in Construction and the Services sector increased (Table 1).


