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# Medicaid Program Changes, 2011

1. Mandatory enrollment into an HMO with July 1, 2011 and August 1, 2011 effective dates:
  - ABD without Medicare
  - All DYFS children
  - All clients with DDD including Community Care Waiver clients (unless dually eligible)
  - Clients who currently have exemptions
  - Clients already enrolled in or covered by a commercial or Medicare HMO
  - Pharmacy lock-in clients
  - Breast and Cervical Cancer program clients

# Medicaid Program Changes, 2011

2. Mandatory enrollment into an HMO, Phase 2 this fall
  - Dually eligible clients (QMB+, SLMB+, Other full duals)
  - GO Waiver clients
  - Other Waiver clients
    - Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
    - AIDS Community Care Alternatives Program (ACCAP)
    - Community Resources for People with Disabilities (CRPD)

# Services in Managed Care on July 1, 2011 for HMO Members

1. Home health care for all HMO members
2. Pharmacy for all HMO members
3. Personal Care Assistant services except Personal Preference Program
4. Adult and pediatric medical day care
5. PT, OT and Speech therapies

# Medicaid Program Changes, 2011

## 3. Open Enrollment Period

- October 1 – November 15, annually

# Services Remaining in Medicaid Fee-for-Service

- Mental health and substance abuse services except for DDD clients
- Nursing facility care beyond 30 days
- Personal preference program
- Transportation through LogistiCare except for emergency ground transportation, which is covered by HMO
- Methodone and its administration
- Institutional services

# HMOs Serving Medicaid Clients

- Amerigroup (in all counties except Salem)
- Healthfirst NJ (in 10 counties)
- Horizon NJ Health (all counties)
- UnitedHealthcare Community Plan (all counties)
