FINAL AGENCY DECISION

OAL DKT. NO. HMA 20008-2015

As Director of the Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services, I have reviewed the record in this case, including the OAL case file and the Initial Decision approving the Settlement Agreement reached by the parties. Procedurally, the time period for the Agency Head to file a Final Decision is July 29, 2016 in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:14B-10 which requires an Agency Head to adopt, reject, or modify the Initial Decision within 45 days of receipt. The Initial Decision was received on June 14, 2016.

This matter arises from the Passaic County Board of Social Services' termination of Petitioner's Medicaid benefits due to the failure to complete a redetermination. At the


scheduled OAL hearing, the parties entered into a settlement on the record whereby Petitioner agreed to withdraw his request for a hearing and Passaic County acknowledged that Petitioner had filed the redetermination forms. By Initial Decision dated June 9, 2016, the ALJ approved the settlement agreement because it was consistent with the law, fully disposed of all issues in controversy and was voluntarily entered into by both parties in accordance with N.J.A.C. 1:11-19.1.

Based on my review of the record, I concur with the ALJ's findings and hereby ADOPT the Settlement Agreement.

THEREFORE, it is on this <sup>14<sup>th</sup></sup> day of JULY 2016,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the Settlement Agreement in this matter is hereby ADOPTED.
