


Based upon my review of the record, I hereby ADOPT the findings, conclusions and recommended decision of the Administrative Law Judge in their entirety and incorporate the same herein by reference. I agree with the Administrative Law Judge that the credible evidence in this record indicates that Petitioner does not satisfy the clinical eligibility criteria necessary to qualify for adult day health services pursuant to N.J.A.C. 10:164-1.5¹. Should Petitioner's condition deteriorate, she may reapply for services.

Additionally, it appears that Petitioner may qualify for social day care, and I suggest that she contact the New Jersey Aging and Disability Resource Connection at 1-877-222-3737 for information about available programs and services.

THEREFORE, it is on this 3rd day of May 2016,

ORDERED:

That the Initial Decision affirming the termination of eligibility for adult day health services is hereby ADOPTED as the Final Decision in this matter.
