TO: County Welfare Agency Directors

SUBJECT: Continued Medicaid Eligibility for Certain SSI Ineligibles

Under federal law, any individual who became ineligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) solely as a result of the January 1, 2014, 1.5% cost-of-living adjustment (COLA) in Social Security benefits is entitled to continue to receive Medicaid benefits. Effective February 1, 2014, County Welfare Agencies (CWAs) will have ongoing responsibility for those individuals. The Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) sent each individual a letter explaining this and the transition to CWA case supervision (copy attached for reference).

The initial Medicaid Only eligibility segment with applicable county of supervision as well as re-determination dates have been updated by DMAHS in the Medicaid Eligibility System (MES) to ensure continuity of benefits including Managed Care. A systemic printout has been prepared from the Social Security Administration's (SSA) file which lists those individuals residing in each county and has been made available to each CWA. Using the printout, the CWA shall prepare a Form FD-346, Certification In Lieu of Application for Medical Assistance Only (copy attached for CWA reproduction) to be kept in each case file to authorize "Medicaid Only" benefits until re-determination. In the past, the CWAs have signed this Certification because they made the changes in the MES system, however, this year DMAHS will be the certifying entity because they made the changes.

Continuing eligibility for Medicaid benefits must be re-determined in accordance with all existing program requirements in conjunction with the added COLA disregard provisions. This provision simply disregards the actual dollar amount of the January 1, 2014, 1.5% Social Security Title II benefit COLA. Moving forward, any subsequent Title II COLAs will also be disregarded for those individuals. The outreach to those affected by this provision will also continue for an additional two years according to the Pickle Amendment/Lynch vs. Rank court rulings.

Additionally, this disregard shall also be applied to any social security income deemed to an individual from a spouse or a parent. This disregard applies only to that special class of former SSI individuals and shall not be applied to other Medicaid applicants/recipients.

IMPORTANT MEDICAID NOTICE KEEP THIS IMPORTANT LETTER

You may have recently received a letter from the Social Security Administration advising you that you are no longer eligible to receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payments because your income exceeds the SSI eligibility standard. This appears to have been caused by the 1.5 percent cost-of-living increase in your Social Security check which is effective January 2014.

However, federal law states that you must be permitted to keep your Medicaid eligibility if the Social Security cost-of-living increase is the **only** reason this supplemental payment was terminated. Therefore, your Medicaid coverage will continue.

Your Medicaid eligibility determination will no longer be under the supervision of the Social Security Administration but will transition to the County Welfare Agency (CWA) in your county of residence. The CWA **will notify you** when you need to renew your Medicaid eligibility. For your convenience, a listing of the County Welfare Agencies is shown on the back of this letter.

Your Health Benefits Identification card and/or managed care (HMO) identification is still valid. Please continue to use it to access medical services.
