Medically Needy Coverage

TAKE NOTICE that the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS), Division of Medical Assistance and Health Services (DMAHS) intends to seek approval from the United States Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS), for a state plan amendment to cease providing nursing facility services to eligible Medically Needy individuals. This will allow individuals to qualify for Medicaid Managed Long-Term Services and Supports (MLTSS), which includes nursing facility services, by establishing a Qualified Income Trust also known as a Miller Trust. This is an irrevocable trust that allows individuals with monthly income above the state's special income limit (SIL) to qualify for Medicaid. Income that exceeds the SIL would be transferred to the trust.

This Notice is intended to satisfy the requirements of Federal law and regulations.
