OPDD FY 2017 RLI Q&A

- 1. There is a requirement to secure a program evaluation by an outside entity at the end of the contract period. Would that be a one-time evaluation at the end of year 3?
 - a. A comprehensive evaluation, conducted by an outside evaluation entity (preferably the same entity for all 3 years), will be required for each year of the project.
- 2. How would such an evaluation entity be sourced?
 - a. Applicants must agree to use an outside entity (preferably from New Jersey) to evaluate the project's effectiveness. In the past, agencies have utilized many of New Jersey's colleges/universities or research companies (for profit or nonprofit).
- 3. Are there any limitations in page length for proposals in the second round?
 - a. Agencies that are invited to submit a comprehensive proposal in round 2 will be provided with a template to utilize for their submission. It will include proposal length parameters.
- 4. Are references useful in the Project Description and if so do they count to the 5 page limit?
 - a. References can be useful in a project description and do not count toward the 5 page limit. However, the excessive use of references, resulting in many additional pages, is discouraged.
