INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft by Deception-Third Degree)

ANDREW HARRIS

between on or about July 1, 2000, and on or about October 30, 2000, at the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception the property of the State of New Jersey, valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said ANDREW HARRIS did purposely obtain unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$5,440.00 by creating or reinforcing the false impression to the State of New Jersey that the said ANDREW HARRIS was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said ANDREW HARRIS then and there well knew, he was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, and N.J.S.A. 2C: 20-2b(4), and


against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of
the same.

COUNT TWO


(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities-Fourth Degree)

ANDREW HARRIS

on or about October 30, 2000, at the City of Trenton, in the County of Mercer, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which he did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form, that is Unemployment Insurance Benefit check number 22841780 dated October 24, 2000, containing a false statement that the said ANDREW HARRIS met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the weeks ending October 14, 2000, and October 21, 2000, and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.


