INDICTMENT

The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Theft By Deception-Third Degree)

EVANGELINE ROSADO

between on or about August 12, 2000 and on or about February 3, 2001, at the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, purposely did obtain by deception property of the State of New Jersey valued in excess of \$500; that is, the said EVANGELINE ROSADO purposely obtained unemployment insurance benefits in the amount of \$7618.00 by submitting or causing to be submitted documents for unemployment insurance benefits of the State of New Jersey, thereby creating or reinforcing false impressions to the State of New Jersey that the said EVANGELINE ROSADO was unemployed;

WHEREAS IN TRUTH AND IN FACT, as the said EVANGELINE ROSADO there and then well knew, she was employed, all contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:20-4, N.J.S.A. 2C:20-2b(4) and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Unsworn Falsification to Authorities- Fourth Degree)


EVANGELINE ROSADO

on or about February 6, 2001, at the Township of Dover, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere, and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly did make a written false statement which she did not believe to be true on or pursuant to a form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable; that is, the said EVANGELINE ROSADO did make and submit or cause to be submitted Unemployment Insurance Benefit check no. 23614533 dated February 5, 2001, containing a false statement that the said EVANGELINE ROSADO did report all earnings and holiday or vacation pay and otherwise met all eligibility requirements to receive unemployment insurance benefits for the week ending February 3, 2001 and said form bearing notice, authorized by law, to the effect that false statements made therein are punishable, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:28-3a, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.
