# Checklist Ordinance Review

### **Checklist Ordinance Overview**

- All Conforming municipalities adopt a Checklist Ordinance
  - Repealed when municipality adopts Land Use Ordinance (LUO)
  - Retained in lieu of LUO when development potential is severely limited ("Checklist Ordinance Approach)
- Requirement established in Plan Conformance Guidelines, adopted by Council in 2008 along with RMP

### **Checklist Ordinance Use**

- Requires referral of Development Applications to the Highlands Council for Consistency with Highlands Act and RMP
- 9 municipalities have adopted a Checklist Ordinance to-date
- "Checklist Ordinance Approach" first used in 2011

### **Development Application Review**

Criteria:

- Consistency with RMP
- Consistency with Highlands Land Use Ordinance

#### Land Use Ordinance Approach

Criteria:

- Consistency with RMP
- Consistency with Highlands Land Use Ordinance
  Reviewer:
- Municipal officials (after training, procedures, forms, fee/escrow, etc. are in place)

**<u>ALL</u>** development applications receive <u>**identical**</u> review for consistency with RMP and protections required by Act.

## LUO and Checklist Ordinance in Plan Conformance Context



- Draft documents prepared during Petition; municipal adoption during implementation
- During staff review of petition documents, evaluate Checklist Ordinance Approach vs. LUO
  - Based heavily on the municipality's development potential
  - Primarily Preservation Area only towns (where Highlands DEP protections already in place)

### Summary: Checklist Ordinance Approach

- Saves municipality with limited development potential time, effort, \$ (training, admin. support)
- ✓ Avoids inefficient use of state funding
- ✓ Gets Resource Management Planning underway more quickly
- ✓ Appropriately addresses Plan Conformance
- ✓ Provides equal resource protection (simply changes location of reviews)
