
WHEREAS, the State Office of Emergency Management, all member agencies of the Disaster Preparedness Commission, and other interested agencies have gathered information and prepared the New Jersey State Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan, in accordance with the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000; and,

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey has afforded state and federal agencies, regional groups, not-for-profit organizations and private citizens an opportunity to comment and provide input into the New Jersey State Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan and the actions of the New Jersey State Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan; and,


