The Grand Jurors of and for the State of New Jersey, upon their oaths, present that:

COUNT ONE

(Conspiracy - Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

and

WILFREDO ACEVEDO

on or about October 9, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, with the purpose of promoting and facilitating the crimes of distribution of a controlled dangerous substance, possession with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance and possession of a controlled dangerous substance, did agree that:

A. One or both of them would engage in conduct which would constitute the aforesaid crimes, or

B. One or both of them would aid in the planning, solicitation and commission of the said crimes, that is:

1. Knowingly or purposely distributing a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of more than one ounce and less than five pounds including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11);

2. Knowingly or purposely possessing with intent to distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of more than one ounce and less than five pounds including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1) and N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11); and

3. Knowingly or purposely possessing a controlled dangerous substance, that is, marijuana, in a quantity of more than fifty grams, a Schedule I controlled dangerous substance, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(3).

All in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:5-2, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT TWO

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance-Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

and

WILFREDO ACEVEDO

on or about October 9, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is marijuana, in a quantity of more than one ounce but less than five pounds including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT THREE

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous
Substance-Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

and

WILFREDO ACEVEDO

on or about October 9, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River,
in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of
this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess with intent to
distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is marijuana,
in a quantity of more than one ounce but less than five pounds
including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the
provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11) and
N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the
government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FOUR

(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance-Fourth Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

and

WILFREDO ACEVEDO

on or about October 9, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did possess a controlled dangerous substance, that is marijuana, in a quantity of more than fifty grams including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-10a(3) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT FIVE

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance
on or within 1,000 Feet of School Property-Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

on or about October 9, 2001 and on or about October 18, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is marijuana, while within 1,000 feet of school property, that being South Toms River Elementary School, which is owned or leased by the Borough of South Toms River and is used for school purposes, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-7 and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SIX

(Distribution of a Controlled Dangerous Substance-Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ

on or about October 18, 2001, at the Borough of South Toms River, in the County of Ocean, elsewhere and within the jurisdiction of this Court, knowingly or purposely did distribute a controlled dangerous substance, that is marijuana, in a quantity of more than one ounce but less than five pounds including any adulterants or dilutants, contrary to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5a(1), N.J.S.A. 2C:35-5b(11) and N.J.S.A. 2C:2-6, and against the peace of this State, the government and dignity of the same.

COUNT SEVEN

(Possession with Intent to Distribute a Controlled Dangerous
Substance-Third Degree)

CHRISTOPHER RODRIGUEZ



(Possession of a Controlled Dangerous Substance-Fourth Degree)


