Driving Directions

From Philadelphia Bridges: Follow signs to Route 130 North - Trenton. Stay on Route 130 North for approx 8 miles (through Cinnaminson, Delran, Willingboro) Look for sign Route 541 (Mercury Lincoln car dealership on the corner) at a traffic light make a right. On the left is Napa Motor Parts, East Second Street will be on the left make a left. The Church is in the middle of the block on the right (across from the back of Burlington City High School)

From Pennsylvania Turnpike: Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 359 Delaware River Bridge Route 276. Follow signs to Route 130 South. Take Route 130 South towards Burlington. Stay on Route 130 until you get to High Street (Route 541) Make a left onto High Street. Stay in left lane. Go through two traffic lights make a left onto East Second Street. The Church is in the middle of the block on the right (across from the back of Burlington City High School)

From Route 295 North/South: Take Route 295 Exit 47B (Route 541-Burlington) Stay on Route 541 approx 2 miles (landmarks: K-Mart, Gulf Gas Station on right at Napa Motor Part make a right (East 2nd Street) The Church is in the middle of the block on the right (across from the back of Burlington City High School)

From New Jersey Turnpike, North/South: Take Exit 5 go through toll booth to traffic light. At light make a left. Go approx. 4 or 5 miles (landmarks: Burlington Center Mall, Wal-mart) Stay on Local Route 541 approx 2 miles (landmarks: Wal-Mart, K-Mart, Mattson's Grocery Store) Make a right onto Second Street (Landmark: Napa Motor Part) make a right (East 2nd Street) The Church is in the middle of the block on the right (across from the back of Burlington City High School)

From Trenton Area: Take Route 130 South to Burlington. Stay on Route 130 until you get to High Street (Route 541) Make a left onto High Street. Stay in left lane. Go through two traffic lights make a left onto East Second Street. The Church is in the middle of the block on the right (across from the back of Burlington City High School)
