Take notice that pursuant to *N.J.S.A. 52:14B-5.1.*c, the Combat Auto Theft Program rules (*N.J.A.C. 13:63*) will expire on March 21, 2014. The Division of State Police has reviewed these rules and determined them to be necessary, reasonable, adequate, efficient, understandable, and responsive to the purpose for which they were originally promulgated. The readoption of all four subchapters and Appendices A and B is necessary because they describe the operation of the program, the responsibilities of program participants and of local police departments and the Division of State Police.

N.J.S.A. 39:3-85.5 et seq. (P.L. 1990, c. 98) and the chapter proposed for readoption establish a voluntary registration program to combat motor vehicle thefts. The program allows for the voluntary participation by all registered owners of motor vehicles. There have been numerous participants in the program since its inception.

No amendments are proposed for the readopted rules. The Division believes the current text of the chapter is sufficient

for the purposes of administering the Combat Auto Theft Program.
