SUBVERSION OF FIREARMS AMMO SALES

TRENTON – The State Commission of Investigation is holding a public hearing today on the ease with which convicted felons and criminal street-gang members in New Jersey can legally obtain ammunition for firearms, particularly handguns.

The hearing is being held beginning at 9:30 a.m. in Committee Room 16 on the fourth floor of the Statehouse Annex. Sworn testimony will be provided by a range of witnesses, including Commission investigators, confidential informants and prominent local, state and federal law enforcement authorities.

The hearings are part of a comprehensive SCI investigation into weakness in laws and regulations governing access to firearms ammunition across the state.
